**LWML: MAKING A DIFFERENCE** - Of course you remember Newtown and it's tragic event at Sandy Hook Elementary just over a year ago. One thing you may not know is that Lutheran Charities played a comforting role in the healing process. They sent some specially trained golden retrievers to the traumatized children, who responded to their affection, expressing fears and emotions not spoken to adults. Lutheran Charities is one of the many recipients of mission grants chosen at the Pittsburgh LWML (Lutheran Women in Mission) Convention this last June. These grants are financed by Mites (pocket change) collected by Lutherans all over the country, including our own congregation.



Our congregation has a group of mission-minded women who not only empty their pockets to support missions; they also get together and do "hands on" work, such as make clothing protectors for assisted living residents, or bibs for the developmentally-disabled in the Dominican Republic, or work with the youth to make fleece blankets for the Mexico Mission, to name a few.

Our next meeting is Tuesday, January 14 at 7PM in Fellowship B. We will have devotions, sign cards for shut-ins, eat treats and discuss our next missions project. We would love to have more of you purposeful, eager-to-serve and mission-minded women join us!

In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to Jesus and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.
