Coming on **August 6th** is the American Red Cross Blood Mobile. If you haven't donated ever, now may be the perfect time for you to participate. There are lots of benefits for giving blood. Here are just a few.

- ◆ 1 pint of blood can save up to 3 lives; 5 million need blood every yr.
- ◆ It's something you can spare – most people have blood to spare... yet, there is still not enough to go around.
- ◆ You will help ensure blood is on the shelf when needed – most people don't think they'll ever need blood, until they do.
- ◆ You will be someone's hero – in fact, you could help save more than one life with just one donation.
- ◆ It feels great to donate!



The blood mobile will be here from 3:00-6:00 p.m. There will be a sign up later this month. It takes just 10-15 minutes to draw a pint of blood, but it takes an average of 45-60 minutes for the complete process. In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to Jesus and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.
