Please do not bring any clothing donations until after Sept 15. The clothing ministry people are taking a little break and getting organized for the fall season. Thank you.





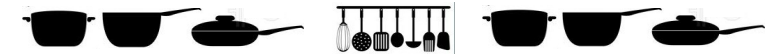

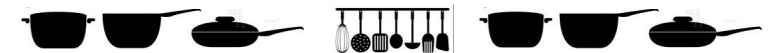
### ReFuel Meals on Wednesdays - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Weeks
