Discipleship

Discipleship is teaching biblical precepts, while modeling and guiding others toward living righteously as followers of Jesus Christ. This should be a cyclical process—meaning once we are discipled, we are to disciple others, and so on. One of the main characteristics of being a disciple, is to develop an intimate relationship with God through Christ rather than just learning about Him.

First, we must realize that discipleship is an ongoing process. We should never quit learning and growing in our walk with Christ. Just as the New Testament disciples who chose to follow Jesus, we too should continually learn and grow stronger in our personal relationship with Him. Do you desire to lead and disciple others along the way with all that you have already learned and experienced? Consider if these are things you do or want to do.

Part of the process includes:

- Transformation and repentance, making God your priority
- Learning Scripture and living by it with commitment
- Loving, edifying, and serving others as God leads
- Focusing on living righteously, being fruitful
- Accountability with godly authority
