There is an English-speaking school educating kids of workers for several organizations deep in Kurdish-held Iraq. There is very little ISIS threat but smack in the middle of a wide open group of people wondering what alternatives they may have to Islam. A teacher can have significant value to the worker-community there as well as direct impact on the lives of the Kurds they live among during the school year.

This is a unique opportunity because you don't need a teaching degree; it is a one-year commitment, and the teachers join a team of Frontiers church-planters and get the exposure to what that can look like inside the Muslim world. The school covers housing, utilities and internet. It is an excellent learning experience and an opportunity to be in the middle of the amazing things God is doing among the Kurds.

It is an English speaking school. Arabic is not required. Kurdish is the language here, but many Kurds speak enough English that someone can get by for awhile as they learn the language. There are a hundred MK or international schools that need teachers. This may be the only one in the midst of a people-movement to Christ.

opportunity to read it at home. (Tom & Liz, Fellowship B)

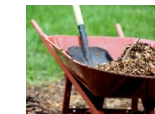
**Hebrews** - We, similar to the Hebrews, are like pilgrims who need a word
