4 Things You Need to Fear if Your Spouse is Low Maintenance

1. It's easy to put my needs before their needs. Marriage calls for us to be one flesh (Genesis 2:24-25), and demands that we put our spouse's needs before our own (Philippians 2:3-4). But, when our spouse is low maintenance, it's easy to put our needs before theirs and to take advantage of them because they're so laid back. Follow the example of Christ in His selfless service and strive to see how you can serve them.

2. I can make things like Valentine's day and date nights a low priority. Often say we don't need February 14th to remind us to love each other. In the process, we can swing the pendulum too far the other way and become lazy and complacent. Ask your low maintenance spouse what they would like for Valentine's Day or their birthday. Don't simply accept their answer without using discernment. Live with your spouse in an understanding way (1 Peter 3:7).

3. I can think our marriage is great because of me. Sometimes, we can think our spouse is truly blessed. Out of all the bad people out there, they did well in landing me. And sometimes, because your spouse doesn't require much from you, you can think your marriage is amazing. Yes, there are some amazing moments, but the reason your marriage is great is because of the grace of God (and because your spouse is awesome). Pursue a life of humility (James 4:6). Be like John the Baptist who said (about Jesus), "He must increase, and I must decrease."

4. I forget how to cherish my spouse. Because they rarely complain, you might forget how to cherish, value, and nourish your low maintenance spouse. We can get lazy and not go out of our way to appreciate them. We want them to be the most cherished spouse around, but if we don't intentionally pursue them, then we will co-exist in a decent marriage, but not a great one. Cherish your spouse, remind them they are important, unique and the best person for you to enjoy and endure life together.
