

Difficult Conversations

The hardest conversation is often the most needed. If it were easy, we would not struggle to do it. Do you need to have a difficult conversation? Consider these steps in preparation:

- Conviction: Is there a sense of urgency towards having the conversation? Is it something you must do to improve or protect the relationship?
- Prayer: Pray for God's favor, open hearts and God's resolution.
- Notes: This will help you speak clearly, not from emotion. Factual, to the point, but kind, truthful, and helpful.
- Setting: Time and place are critical in difficult situations. Pay attention to when and where.
- Rehearsal: The more you do this the better you'll be able to control your emotions.
- Action: Do it soon or it will be harder and more awkward.
- Follow Up: Continue clarifying and building on your start.

Jesus, open minds and hearts to receive the words of truth and love. May those words be healing, restore relationships and build the bonds of peace. Amen.
