



When Life is a Freefall


Do you attend church and sit by friends you have known for years and yet find it difficult, if not impossible, to share your deepest struggles with them? Do you believe you should be a perfect saint while feeling like a part of your life is in freefall and you don't dare to talk about it?

A big factor in this dilemma is a pattern of unwillingness to talk about certain uncomfortable issues within the Church. For example, addictions, sexuality, mental illness, and loneliness to name a few. We choose to ignore them, try to cover them up or discount people who bring them up. These are issues that as individuals we struggle with, and issues the church body should be talking about. Paul in Galatians urged the Church to "Bear each other's burdens". With more grace and love we can bring light to the dark places in each other's hearts. Church then becomes a safe haven to confront those uncomfortable places in our lives.




This congregation supports itself through the gifts of its members. We do not ask for any certain amount from each member; we want each person to give as Jesus leads them.

We have a variety of ways to give. You can give using the envelopes in the pew for checks or cash, and you can give online through automatic withdrawal from your checking/savings account or a debit/credit card. We use Vanco for our online giving, and they have the highest level of online security.

Initial registration of an account for online giving may be done directly by you on our website, although a person does not have to register to be able to give. By registering an account you have the following options available:

1. Access your secure account through the BSLC website where you can view all of your account transactions.
2. Set-up and change your scheduled giving and/or account information through the website (change frequency of payments, amount of payments, bank account information, add a donation, cancel a donation, etc.)



Whether registered or not, online giving will allow you to...

- ◆ Support the ministry needs (general budget, missions, etc.)
- ◆ Pay for preschool/ kindergarten tuition
- ◆ Pay for retreats or special events

In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to JESUS and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in JESUS as their SAVIOR who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of JESUS and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement, it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with the pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.
