### How Are We Known?

The question was simple: "What is your church known for in its community?"

Within a few minutes of my post, many responses came forth. After I read and added all of them, I saw three patterns emerge.

- About one-half of the churches are known for ministries that require the community to come to the church itself.
- About one-fourth of the churches cited great ministries in and to the community.
- About one-fourth of the churches said they were known for negative reasons.

Many of our churches are doing an incredible job connecting with and ministering to the communities in which they are located. And though I am certainly glad to see many church members excited about what is taking place on their church campuses, I fear many members think that community ministry means, "Y'all come to us, and we will minister to you."
