Ways to Help Foster Children

Emergency Needs List

The North Clackamas office keeps an email list of volunteers interested in receiving requests from DHS staff to benefit children. We're committed to only sending requests an average of twice/month. A larger pool would help with the community's ability to respond. It's a tangible way for folks to directly help children in care, bless families, and encourage DHS staff. Respite Care

One of the biggest needs voiced from foster families over and over again is respite care. We're compiling a list of volunteers interested in providing respite care for Embrace Oregon foster families, and will facilitate opportunities to connect them with families in need during the next year (i.e. Respite Mix & Mingle, see below). Respite providers can watch kids overnight for one night or up to two weeks to give foster families a much needed break; and the arrangement is made between the respite provider and foster family.

It's that time again for the **Portland National Christian College Fair!** The college fairs are a great opportunity for students and families to meet with college representatives to learn about the value of Christian higher education.

Students will be able to interact with over 40 Christian colleges and universities at the fair to find out more about each school and ask lots of questions.
