Let's Show Our Appreciation

In Protestant denominations, October has been identified as Pastor Appreciation month. Some ways we can do that:

1. Pray regularly for Pete, Melissa and their four girls

3. Express appreciation, written and spoken.
4. Respect his time, and encourage him to get appropriate rest and renewal.
5. Live in peace, and deal with conflict in biblical ways before going to him.
6. Discover and encourage him in his personal interests.
7. Support a strategy for professional connections, including outside of ministry.
8. Encourage him to plan significant and meaningful time with his loved ones.
9. Lovingly insist he take time for prayer retreats, and provide resources/volunteers for his duties to be covered in his absence.
10. Ask Melissa what special/unique challenges confront her, and be sensitive to expectations inappropriately placed upon her.

In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to Jesus and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.
