Anyone providing a turkey or ham should bring it to the church cooked and sliced (not frozen or uncooked).



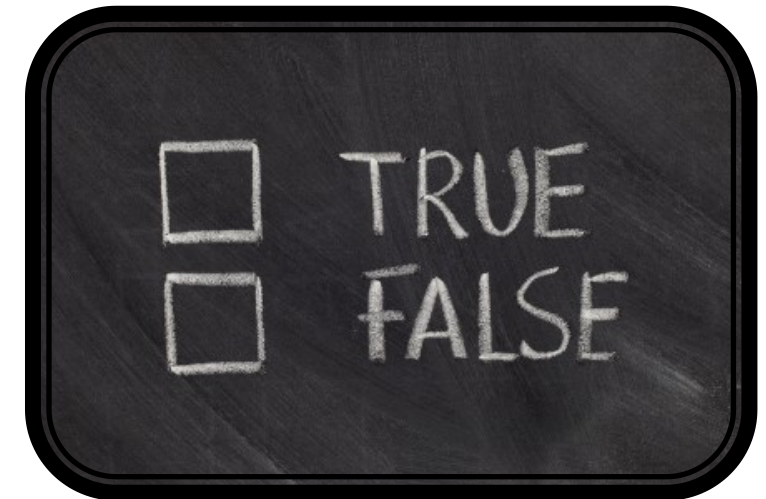

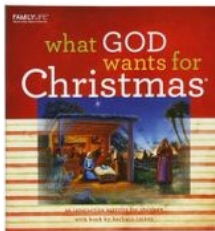
