Ordinary Gems of Lent

What are the objects, the things, that you most associate with Lent and Jesus' journey to the cross? Is it the thirty pieces of silver for which Judas betrayed Jesus? The dice used by the soldiers to determine who would get Jesus' very last earthly possession? The whip? The crown of thorns? For our midweek services this Lent, we are going to devotionally consider several of these objects. As we do so, each week we will learn to appreciate yet one more facet of this priceless gem of Jesus' sacrifice.



And so that you have true "take home points" as a result of these services, each household in attendance is invited to literally take home the objects we will be considering. It will start Ash Wednesday (March 6th) with a simple wooden cross. Each week there will be an additional item to include around your cross, as we follow Jesus to His death and anticipate His promised resurrection.

A light supper will be served from 6:00-6:30 p.m. in the Fellowship Hall, and the services will begin at 6:45 p.m. in the sanctuary, concluding roughly by 7:30 p.m.

In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to Jesus and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.

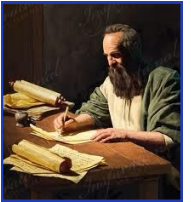
