# Frequently Asked Questions

**What kind of service can I expect?** We have a beautiful mix of traditional hymns and contemporary songs. We project words and lyrics on the wall for ease of reading and participating. You are welcome to wear whatever you feel comfortable in when around other people.

**How about my children?** Children and one of their significant adults are invited up to the front for the Family Message during the service. Art bags are available in the lobby to help children focus on age-related activities. Upstairs is a staffed nursery for babies and toddlers and a cry room at the back right for nursing or fussy little ones.

**When and how do you serve communion?** On the 1st & 3rd Sunday. The rows of people are ushered to front kneelers where the elements are offered by elders with multiple options based on preference.

**Do you have Sunday School classes for all ages?** Yes. Children are in upstairs classrooms, youth downstairs and adults in Fellowship A.


## Good Reads on Following Jesus

As we deny ourselves and follow Jesus, it inevitably means that we are loving those around us and telling them about Him. Here are some books in our library that will help us grow in that way.


**Be Kind to Your Guest** (kids, Berry) - Give your young ones the tools to treat their friends with kindness and learn the gift of hospitality. (You will laugh at the comical bunny and old-fashioned manners.)



**Last Flight Out** (video, WWP) - Pilot Dan's mission: rescue a woman working a jungle clinic in midst of warfare. She and another are willing to sacrifice their lives for villagers. A daring rescue results in a changed life. Planes, helicopter, explosions, and Samaritan's Purse are elements.



**Love Has a Price Tag** - Join Elisabeth Elliot as she "thinks out loud" about love of God, love of spouse, love of children, love of animals. She sets the stage with an autobiographical sketch that reveals love's price tag in her own life.



**The Twilight of Courage** - Sink into a good chair with this historical war fiction that is a retelling of World War II which intertwines the stories of two American journalists' escape from the collapse of Warsaw with those of an orphaned baby's journey to Jerusalem, a mathematician's attempt to crack Nazi code, and others.
