### “Everything must be done so that the church may be built up.”

1 Corinthians 14 describes a worship service where more than one person spoke truth from the Bible. We enjoy His Stories where Jesus intersects with our lives. So surely we would find value in multiple voices giving expression to how God is working through the Bible in their life.

What if we made opportunities in the worship service for a simple meditation on the readings for that Sunday? It would be just 2-5 minutes sharing what part of the passage spoke to you (what did you underline or highlight or have a question about?) and how has God used that in your life (maybe an encouragement, maybe a repentance, maybe a change of action, maybe a question still isn't answered yet, etc). It is essentially a His Story which starts with the Bible.

How powerful would it be for our body to see so many people sharing from the Bible about a living Jesus? How would it impact our kids growing up with so many voices and examples of people listening to and following Jesus from the Bible?

You could get a Sunday's reading of 1-2 chapters weeks to months in advance. You would have time to read it over and over and listen to how it impacts you. It doesn't require you to read commentaries or dig deep into context or theology or cross references. But it could benefit from talking with others (spouse, small group, non-Christian friend). Then on the Sunday assigned for that reading be present in both services or record on a video. Simple, authentic, real faith is the goal. I would be happy to consult with you on any questions about meaning or presentation, etc.
