- Vine Project Team: Report on next steps for the Discipleship Pathway; Purpose of small groups and next steps to connecting The team is continuing to move forward, working through the Vine Project book. The group is planning carefully in order to have the Vine Project be an ongoing means of discipleship, rather than something that disappears. A Wednesday evening church-wide study, "The Thing Is," will be starting on March 1 as a means of having a small-group opportunity open to all; the study will expose people to some of the terminology of the Vine Project.

#### C. Discussion/Action Items:

# 1. February Annual Topic: Elder sharing > Contact with staff assigned to their flock: How is everything going for the staff member?

Each elder shared the responses of their assigned staff member to questions in the Contact Guide. Pastor Kevin and Pastor John were both able to speak directly to some of the questions. Elders asked some clarifying questions.

#### 2. Elders Policy Committee - Policy on Admission of New and Returning Members

Pastor Kevin shared the draft of the new policy: Admission of New Members, 2023. Elders were invited to review it and give feedback to Pastor Kevin. The final draft will be shared for adoption at a future meeting.

## 3. Debrief Elder/New Member Luncheon; give input for next event

Elders shared positive comments on the number attending, as well as the number with children. The balance of new members to visitors was approximately 50/50. There was a suggestion to have an activity for the children after the lunch portion. Having a mix of new members and visitors was voiced as a positive, due to the cross-sharing between them. Another suggestion was to have the luncheon after each Discovery Class. A question was raised, "Are we doing enough to connect with visitors?"
