Our biggest cross-cultural outreach is the Mexico Mission Trip. We encourage you to ask Jesus if He wants you to go this June to be a willing servant and ambassador of His Good News. Applications are at the Connect Center and online under DO GOOD. Applications will be received from now until April 30th. The trip is limited to the first 30 applicants and it only costs \$400 for adults or \$375 for students to get your transportation, delicious food and simple lodging covered for the trip, though meals in the states are at your own expense. 
"Children are a heritage from the Lord, offspring a reward from him." Ps 127:3

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing.
