At times his bravery was inspiring, but other times his cowardice makes us wince. Yet God used this disciple of Jesus to help start His church, and we have two of his letters in the Bible: 1 & 2 Peter. But does Rocky still speak to the issues of today's world, or has he become irrelevant? Let's find out together as I guide a Bible Study on the letters of Rocky Johnson.
