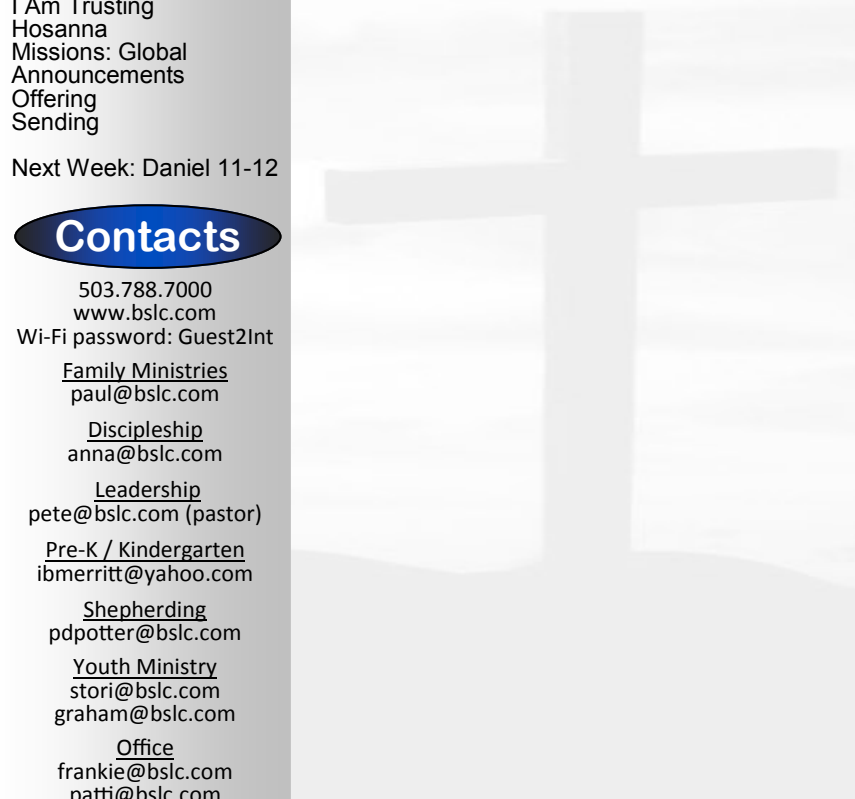

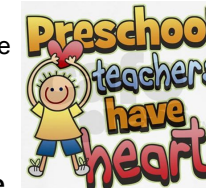
The BSLC Preschool Board of Directors wants to advertise two positions for the preschool which will be for the 2014-2015 school year.
