International Students Inc. has been around for more than 63 years as a non-denominational, non-profit ministry organization that mobilizes and works with a variety of evangelical churches and Christian individuals to share the love of Christ with international college students and visiting scholars throughout the United States.

Kerry is the City Director and oversees six staff members. He and his wife, Josie, lead an outreach to students at WSU-Vancouver. The Pacific Northwest Adult & Teen Challenge is a 501 (c)(3) non-profit, faith-based program. Our Portland Metro Campus serves men who are 18 years or older, whose lives are being destroyed by life-controlling problems such as drugs, alcohol, gang activity, destructive behavior, or other negative life styles.

Adult & Teen Challenge is an international Christian program with over 50 years of history providing assistance, supporting, and challenging people to make the right choices by turning away from their destructive life styles.

The staff members and volunteers at Adult & Teen Challenge are here because they believe that the Lord has called them to this ministry to reach-out and help desperate people seek and find answers.

Adult & Teen Challenge does not receive federal or state funding, but is locally supported and entirely dependent upon free will gifts, contributions, our work programs, fundraisers, and TC Resale & Donation stores.

TC Resale & Donation stores exist to financially support Pacific Northwest Adult and Teen Challenge, to provide vocational training to the students in our recovery programs, and to impact our communities. There is a store in Milwaukie and Portland.

Vocational Training

Every day we have over 60 students working in our stores, gaining real work experience in a healthy environment. Their training provides an opportunity to enhance their resumes and help them secure employment after they graduate.

Financial Support

Almost half of the revenue for our recovery programs is raised through our stores. In 2015 alone, we received nearly \$100,000 in our donation jars to support global missions and our annual camp.

Community Impact

Our stores offer a tremendous variety of merchandise, from collectibles and vintage items to clothes, furniture, and more. We offer some of the lowest prices in town, and provide donation pick-up.
