Stephen Ministry is hosting an evening seminar that addresses a relevant and important issue in our culture. Steve has his Masters in Marriage & Family Therapy from George Fox College. He has shared more than 3000 hours counseling couples and people considering divorce. Come and hear how you can better minister and understand those struggling in their marriage.

- Background stats on families in crisis

How Are We Known?

The question was simple: “What is your church known for in its community?”

Within a few minutes of my post, many responses came forth. After I read and added all of them, I saw three patterns emerge.

- About one-half of the churches are known for ministries that require the community to come to the church itself.
- About one-fourth of the churches cited great ministries in and to the community.
- About one-fourth of the churches said they were known for negative reasons.

Many of our churches are doing an incredible job connecting with and ministering to the communities in which they are located. And though I am certainly glad to see many church members excited about what is taking place on their church campuses, I fear many members think that community ministry means, “Y’all come to us, and we will minister to you.”

In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to Jesus and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.
