Tips for Groups

Small groups can be a powerful source of support, encouragement and accountability. This happens best when we are vulnerable and share that part of us that we often do not want any to see. When we have a deep level of trust in the group it allows us to share the good and the bad knowing the response will be non-judgmental and filled with grace. But this group of people who love us and walk in like brokenness also challenge us to change.
