C. Discussion/Action Items:

1. August Topic: Board facilitator and DB Reps for coming year

Board Facilitator: Brian Salvey - Elected Unanimously

Directors Board Reps - Volunteers: Bob Hinze, David Lane - Elected Unanimously

2. August Topic: Review of membership & confirmation processes

Membership - Review of current policy

Motion: When a child of a family unit turns 18, they would automatically be assigned an elder. If they are confirmed, they would automatically become a voting member; otherwise they would be invited to go through the membership class and then become a member.

Passed Unanimously (Pastor Kevin will add this to the membership policy.)

- One former member is asking to become a member, as a returner. Approved.
- When children are confirmed, should they become voting members?

This would require a constitutional change. Both pastors come from settings in which, once confirmed, they could vote. Elder discussion showed, with one exception, elders did not support making a change, but want to keep the voting age at 18. No decision was made to propose a change to our current practice (per constitution)

Confirmation

Confirmation is a year-long process that involves parents. Starts in October, if there are participants. Currently there are 3 senior high students who have not been confirmed. Confirmation content covers primarily the 10 commandments, the creed, baptism. It culminates in a faith story at the end of the year.

Once confirmed, then we want them involved in the congregation.

3. August Topic: Plan for/Assign Adult Bible Classes, Sundays

Current structure: Missional partners present 5 minutes during worship, then during Bible class; The last Sunday of the month is Community Sunday with no class.

Continue to have Missional Partners present during Bible class?

Elder Support to continue: Unanimous

Continue to have Community Sunday (no class) the last Sunday of the month?

Discussion and comments included: Are we utilizing it well? Some businesses who have been impacted, remember that we care. It started strong, but has fallen off; not utilized well.

No decision made; continue discussion next month.

4. Review of Ministry Budgets for possible Reductions

Ministries were asked to review their budgets for reductions. The board review of the all ministry budgets did not identify <u>any</u> areas of large increases by individual ministries. Therefore, the board would prefer that ministries not be asked to make cuts. The deficit of \$25,000 seems reasonable. **With unanimous agreement from the board,** Pastor Kevin will communicate this to the Directors Board.
