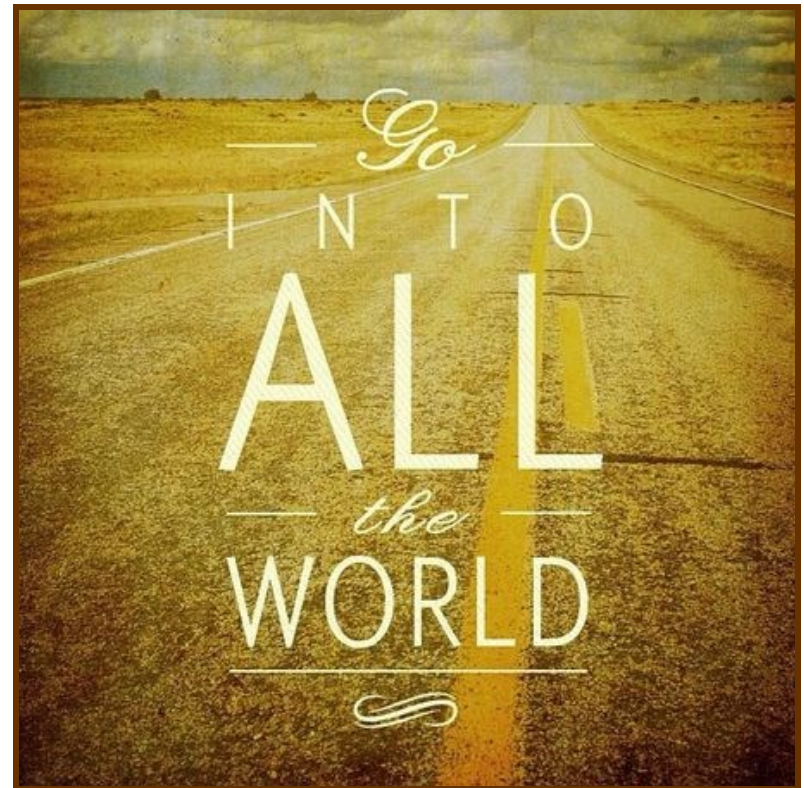

Grief Recovery Weekend

Are you, or someone you love, grieving the end of a marriage from a death, divorce or permanent separation? A Beginning Experience Weekend can help with the healing from such a loss. The next opportunity to attend one will be the weekend of October 2 - 5, 2015, in Milwaukie, near Clackamas Town Center.

The retreat consists of presentations by Beginning Experience team members, periods for private personal reflection and sharing in small groups. The weekend begins on Friday evening and concludes Sunday afternoon. The cost of \$195 includes lodging for 2 nights in a double room, 5 meals and resource materials. Special arrangements may be made for payment, and partial scholarships are available. Single rooms are available for an additional \$20.
