Stepping In and Supporting

Dealing with grief is a heavy burden and brings feelings of isolation and indecision. Starting Oct 9 on **Mondays at 6 p.m.** at Calvary Chapel in Milwaukee (13250 SE Pheasant Ct) is a grief recovery support

group called **GriefShare**. GriefShare groups meet weekly to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. Each GriefShare session has three distinct elements: 1) video seminar with experts 2) support group discussion and 3) personal study and reflection. Each 13-week session is self-contained so you can join at any session. If you have questions, you can contact the office or talk with Liz B, who is new to BSLC, but very experienced with GriefShare.

A seminar that GriefShare also provides is called Surviving the Holidays. This evening event lasts for two hours and helps you learn:

- How to deal with the many emotions you'll face during the holidays
- What to do about traditions and other coming changes
- Helpful tips for surviving social events
- How to discover hope for your future

In *1 Corinthians 11*, Paul tells us of the power of Communion to forgive sins and unite us to Jesus and each other. Paul invites each of us to examine our self so that we receive this gift well. Those who receive communion well are baptized Christians who:

1. Trust in Jesus as their Savior who provides full forgiveness through His death on the cross.
2. Repent of all known sins, wanting to change their life.

In this gift we received the real presence of Jesus and a real unity with each other. If you are not in agreement it is best to refrain and then come and discuss this with a pastor. If a child has been prepared for communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift. Anyone may come to receive a blessing. Grape juice and gluten/soy/dairy/nut/corn/yeast-free options are available upon request.
