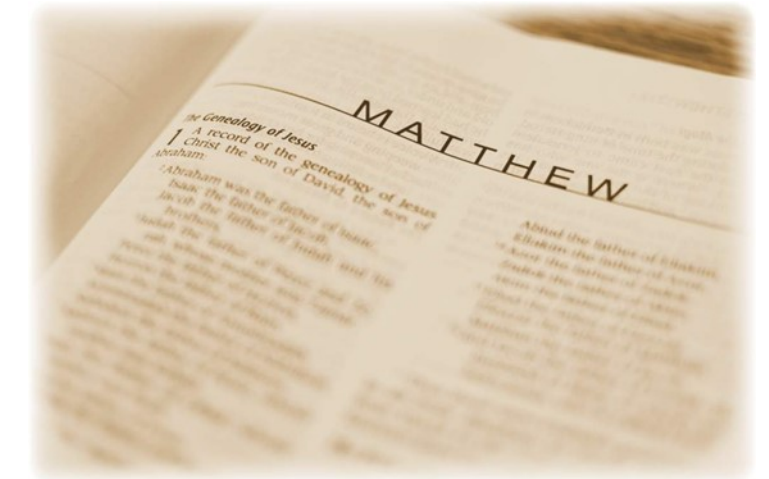

come and discuss this with the pastor. If a child has been prepared for
communion by formal instruction, they are invited to receive this gift.
